#### **SHUT DOWN!** Doors closed at Bromborough Library and Civic Centre Work to retain community asset continues



Jo, Kieran and Ruth continue to support efforts to keep our civic centre open for the local community Despite a huge campaign, Bromborough Library and Civic Centre closed at the end of October. The closure is a direct result of budget cuts pushed through by Labour and Conservative councillors and opposed by the Green Party.

However, the site is, hopefully, on the way to being turned into a community hub. Thanks to persistent campaigning by Greens and the Friends of Bromborough Library, Wirral Council has finally agreed to make Bromborough Civic Centre available for a Community Asset Transfer. This means not-forprofit organisations can apply to run the centre for community benefit. Already, at least three local groups have expressed an interest.

# Greens press hard for return of full timetable at Bromborough Rake

Green councillors have been pressing hard to reverse the outrageous cuts to train services at Bromborough Rake station. Despite having one of the most reliable networks in the country, Merseyrail - jointly owned by Serco and Abellio - has slashed services at Bromborough Rake from up to six trains per hour to just two per hour. This, they say, is to improve overall reliability. However, since the change, many trains sit at Birkenhead Central for several minutes instead of stopping at Bromborough Rake.

Greens and local campaigners took the case to the Labourcontrolled City Region Transport Committee. Incredibly, Labour councillors would not even allow public questions. Members of the public were gagged and refused the right to speak about the impact of these cuts. Merseyrail still insists that services will only be restored when new trains (already three years late) come into service.

- Potholes fixed on Palatine Road
- Drainage improved on **Bromborough Village Road** and covers made flush on **Croft Avenue**.

- Landlord rent increases, damp and repair arrears challenged in **Port Sunlight village**
- Grass and mud cleared from cycle path on New Chester Road, opposite Marine Drive.

#### **NEW FERRY ACTION.....**

- Fly-tipping removed from behind Ingleby, Woodford, Napier, Cecil, Henthorne, Seaview, Elmbank and Willowbank Roads, Marguis Street and New Ferry Park
- Pathway cleared of vegetation from Delta Road East to The Dell and Easton Road to New Ferry Road
- Disabled parking bays repainted on Grove Street
- Levelled pavements on Legh Road and Salisbury Drive
- Hedges cut back and potholes filled on Windsor Close
- New litter bins for **New Ferry Precinct** and **Pool Bank**
- Free cash point re-opened at New Ferry Post Office.
